What is REBUILDING TOGETHER™ GREATER DES MOINES?

Rebuilding Together is the leading volunteer organization that, in partnership with the community, rehabilitates the houses of low-income homeowners, particularly the elderly, disabled and families with children, so that they may continue to live in warmth, safety and independence.

All work is performed free of charge to the homeowner. Referrals come from faith communities, community organizations, service groups and individuals. The homeowner, if physically able, works with the volunteers in the spirit of neighbor helping neighbor.

In 2003, work was done on 32 single family homes and three not-for-profit agencies during the Greater Des Moines' area Rebuilding Together™ Greater Des Moines annual spring Rebuilding Day. The Meredith Foundation sponsored a fall Rebuilding Day that completed 18 more homes. The next Annual Rebuilding Day is scheduled for May 1, 2004.

Who is Eligible?

Any low income, elderly or disabled Greater Des Moines area homeowner is eligible. Repairs vary from major renovations of electrical or plumbing systems to minor repairs such as patching and painting walls to landscaping, yard cleanup, and trash removal. Smoke detectors, new locks, grab bars and ramps may be installed. Volunteers must be able to complete repairs in one day.

Homes are inspected and evaluated individually and determination is then made as to whether a home meets eligibility criteria for volunteer renovation.
